Ronald Arron – Artistic Director of Counseling Center Chamber Series. Assistant Principal Viola Cincinnati Symphony 18 years, member of MET Orchestra 20 years until retirement in 2005. Principal Violist NY POPS. Has been on faculty of Congress of Strings and Manhattan School of Music Prep Division.

Edward Arron – Artistic coordinator of Metropolitan Museum Artists in Concert. Artistic Director of Caramoor Virtuosi, Alpenglouw Festival in CO. and Musical Masterworks Series succeeding Charles Wadsworth after his retirement. Past summer festival appearances at Ravinia, Salzburg, Mostly Mozart, Tanglewood, Bridgehampton, Santa Fe, Seattle and Spoleto USA.



Jeewon Park – 2007 Caramoor Rising Star. Performed solo and chamber music at Carnegie's Weill, Tully, Merkin, Barge, Bridgehampton, and Norfolk. Soloed with Korean Symphony, Charleston Symphony, and Mexico City Philharmonic orchestras. Collaborated with Fine Arts Quartet and NY Phil Chamber Ensemble.

Jane Bunnell – Has sung in over 30 roles in 350 performances with MET Opera. Performed with opera companies in Vienna, Cologne, Toulouse. Houston, Minnesota, NY City Opera with notable conductors as Levine, Gergiev, Ozawa and Robert Shaw.



David Chan – Concertmaster of the MET Opera. Prize winner in Tchaikowsky and Indianapolis International Violin Competitions. Has soloed with MET Orchestra, Moscow State, Los Angeles Phil, Taiwan, Indianapolis, San Diego and Richmond Symphonies.



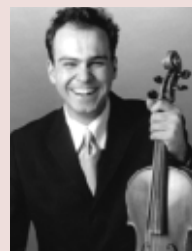
Anthony McGill – Principal Clarinet of MET Opera. Formerly Associate Principal Clarinet of Cincinnati Orchestra. Invited to perform for President Obama's inauguration with Yo-Yo Ma and Itzhak Perlman. Has collaborated with Lang Lang, Midori, Guarneri, Tokyo, and Shanghai Quartets.

Charles Wadsworth – Founding Artistic Director Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center and led it for 20 years. Commissioned works of Bernstein, Barber, Menotti, Bolcom Boulez. For fifty years a fixture as performer and chamber music presenter for the Spoleto Festival in both Italy and Charleston.



Theodore Arm – Has performed as chamber musician with Chamber Music Society at Lincoln Center and Boston. Member of acclaimed chamber group TASHI. Performs regularly at Chamber Music Northwest, Sarasota, Angel Fire, Kneisel Hall. Currently Professor of Violin at University of Connecticut.

Jesse Mills – Performs many genres from classical, contemporary, improvisation, and jazz. Has performed at Tully, Carnegie's Weill, Boston's Gardiner Museum, Marlboro, and Ravinia. Has recorded for Naxos, Tzadik, Stretch and on the jazz label Verve.



Max Mandel – Currently a member of the FLUX Quartet. Performs regularly with Kirby Quartet, Silk Road Ensemble, MET Museum Artists in Concert, Smithsonian Chamber Players, Caramoor Virtuosi, Blarvuster. Collaborated from Vera Beth to Kirk Hammett with Metallica.
